TENTH AMENDMENT TO COURT'S ORDER OF MARCH 13, 2020  
RE: CORONAVIRUS

Acting under the authority of Article V, Section 1 of Constitution of 1974, and the inherent power of this Court, and considering the continual outbreak of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) in Louisiana, the announcement made by Governor John Bel Edwards on August 2, 2021 and Proclamation Number 137 JBE 2021 regarding the state-wide mask mandate and the increasing infection rates in St. Tammany and Washington Parishes;

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that all individuals are required to wear a mask in the St. Tammany Parish Justice Center and the Washington Parish Courthouse.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that only persons, who are noticed with an in-person Court appearance or have an appointment with an agency located in the Courthouse, shall be permitted to enter.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that civil and criminal jury trials are suspended during the month of August 2021.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that all potential jurors noticed to appear in either St. Tammany or Washington Parishes, on August 9, 16, 23, and 30, 2021, are excused and not required to appear.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** the Court's order remains in effect until modified specifically by amendment.
